## **Summer School Event**

The **Coventry University Summer School** offers an exciting opportunity to experience some of the historic and modern culture of England and, at the same time, to have an insight into student life at Coventry University.

Living in one of our centrally located halls of residence, students will attend three interactive workshops with the focus on social, political and cultural issues. Courses are taught on Coventry University campus and this will enable students to have a stimulating and valuable academic experience in a British university at first hand.

Outside the classroom, a diverse range of social and cultural activities are on offer, together with an extensive travel programme around the UK.

**The Summer School costs** include all tuition fees, airport transfers (but flights are not included), housing in Quadrant Hall accommodation, a partial meal plan, including weekday breakfasts, packed lunches on activities days, buffet lunches on workshop days, a Welcome Lunch and a Farewell Gala Dinner. There will be four study trips to well-known places in England which might include London, Oxford, Bath, York, Stratford-upon-Avon (Shakespeare's birthplace) and Warwick Castle. (Precise destinations will be finalised nearer the time). There will also be a free weekend to give you an opportunity to have time to explore England on your own. There will be further opportunities to enjoy local life in the evenings.
